## Nature Playgroup Road Show

The Nature Playgroup Road Show provides families with children (aged 1 – 5 years) an opportunity to meet and explore the outdoor natural environments & playgrounds located in the West.

It will be a place for the children to climb trees, build cubbies, search for bugs, make mud pies, jump in puddles, make nature art – and more.

The program runs on Mondays in line with the school terms and will be held at different locations around the West.

### **What happens at the Nature Playgroup Road Show**

Meet at Kalaya Children's Centre at 10am where we will all hop on the Kalaya bus. Enjoy reading a nature based book together with your child while we travel to our different location on the bus.

There will be plenty of free play as well with children encouraged to choose what they want to do, there will also be a mat set-up with a nature-based activity. We will return to Kalaya on the bus between 12 and 12.30pm.

### **What to bring to the Nature Playgroup Road Show**

Please bring your child's snacks and/or lunch and plenty of water to drink. A full change of clothes is strongly recommended (including underwear), along with a towel and plastic bag for wet and dirty clothes. You might like to bring rubber boots for mud play. On colder days it is recommended you bring wet weather gear such as waterproof pants and raincoats. Hats and sunscreen are also recommended when the UV Rating reaches 3 & above.

### **Other Important Information:**

It is the parents/caregivers responsibility to supervise their child at all times. Younger siblings are also welcome to attend, however it is recommended that you bring a sling or carrier for your baby as some locations aren't pram friendly.

It is your responsibility to decide what type of risky activities you feel comfortable with your child partaking in. Remember you know your child and their abilities better than anyone. Please ensure that you are close to your child and able to intervene when needed.

In case of severe weather (e.g. strong wind, high temperature or storms) playgroup will be cancelled. Families will be advised via text message.
